Opinion

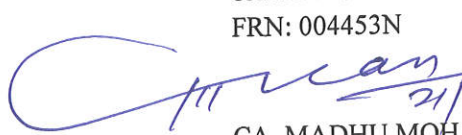

(Annexed to and forming part of the accounts for the year ending 31st March 2017)

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, on **cash basis of accounting**, in conformity with generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) prevalent in India and in compliance with accounting standards applicable on the trust issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

The following accounting policies are followed (wherever applicable) by the trust while preparing financial statements.

1. METHOD OF ACCOUNTING & REVENUE RECOGNITION

The Accounts of the **Clean Ganga Fund** are prepared under the historical cost convention on cash basis of Accounting for all receipts and expenses during the year except of Interest accrued on FDR and other Securities if any should be taken in the year of accrual.

2. FIXED ASSETS

Fixed Assets will be shown on historical cost. Assets which are deteriorated / not usable have been written off during the year.

3. FOREIGN EXCHANGE TRANSACTIONS

Donations or income received in foreign currency are deposited in State Bank of India and are recorded at the rate prevailing on the date of receipt of amount.

4. EXTRAORDINARY ITEMS

Prior period items and extraordinary items are separately classified, identified and dealt with as required, if any as required under Indian Accounting Standard 8 issued by ICAI.



NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

(Annexed to and forming part of the accounts for the year ending 31st March 2017)

1. Clean Ganga Fund has been created vide "Clean Ganga fund Trust Deed" executed on 21st January 2015 by Shri. Rajiv Ranjan Mishra, Joint Secretary & Mission Director, National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) as Author/Settlor of the Trust in official capacity and in accordance with the approval of the Cabinet of Ministers, Government of India vide number 43/CM/2014(i) dated 28th September 2014 appointing 6 persons as trustees as following

- Minister of Finance, Government of India (Chairman)
- Secretary Minister of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, GR & RD)
- Secretary(Economic Affairs), Ministry of Finance (MoF)
- Secretary, Ministry of Overseas Indian Affairs (MOIA),
- Secretary, Ministry of Environmental , Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC)
- Joint Secretary & Mission Director, National Mission for Clean Ganga , Ministry of Water Resources , River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, GR & RD).

2. During the year ending 31.03.2017 of Clean Ganga Fund (CGF) has received donation from-

3. Last year figures have been regrouped/ reclassified whenever considered necessary.
4. Donations received from NRI (Abroad) is directly received in Clean Ganga Fund State Bank of India, Current Account or through SBI E-pay which transfers accumulated amount of donations on regular basis to Clean Ganga Fund , SBI Account.
5. As certified by management, there is no Cash in hand as on 31.03.2017. Further there is no staff and no expenses except Bank Charges has been incurred by Clean Ganga Fund for the year ended 31.03.2017.



6. Provisions of FCRA Act, 2010 with respect of Foreign Contribution/Donations received is exempt vide letter no F.NO.2(12)-B(S)/2014 by Government of India, Ministry of Finance.
7. The Clean Ganga Fund has FDR's of Rs 1,63,74,53,938 on 31.03.17 (Previous Year – 98,17,82,406/-) with State Bank of India, New Delhi, Main Branch. Balance with FDR and Interest Accrued thereon has been taken as certificate provided by Bank. FDR's wise details not maintained in ledgers. Physical copies of FDR's are not collected from bank and not given to any authorities. Difference between FDR made as per ledger and Bank Certificate has been taken as 'Interest on FDR's'.
8. Income of Clean Ganga Fund is exempt u/s 10(23C) (vi) vide notification by Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Income tax return is required to be filled u/s 139 under Income Tax Act, 1961 but the same could not filled due to expiry of due date.
